

Frequently Asked Questions

Q1. How many guests can The Fifth Floor hold?

The Fifth Floor can accommodate up to 150 guests for wedding ceremonies, luncheons, and seated dinners, and up to 400 guests for a standing reception.

Q2. What is your alcohol policy?

Alcohol is permitted at The Fifth Floor; however, service must be provided exclusively by one of our preferred bartending partners, Creative Entertainment or Salud Bartending. Alcohol is not allowed under any circumstances without one of these licensed bartenders—no exceptions will be made.

Q3. What is parking like?

Free parking is available on the south side of the building, under the arch, and does not require a parking pass or permit. If this lot is full, guests may park directly across the street in the Eccles Parking Garage, which is self-pay—simply scan the QR code at the entrance to complete your purchase. Free street parking and additional complimentary parking are also available at The Junction.

Frequently Asked Questions

Q1. What is your policy on food?

We offer an outstanding preferred catering list that we highly recommend; however, couples are not required to use our preferred caterers. You are welcome to choose any caterer you prefer, as The Fifth Floor has an open-door catering policy with no additional fees.

Q2. Do we need to provide insurance?

Liability insurance is encouraged, but it is not required.

Q3. What is your cleaning policy?

All cleaning is fully handled by The Fifth Floor—no cleanup is required from you. At the end of the night all you are responsible for is taking your personal belongings with you.

Q4. How late can I host my event?

As late as you'd like, with an additional late-night fee applying for events that continue past 11:00 p.m.
